Sub:- Supplying, fixing, operation and maintenance of Vehicle tracking solution on rental Basis to the vehicles in ULBs of the state of Andhra Pradesh-RFP - Reg.

Ref:- RFP invited vide Superintending Engineer(PH) Guntur NIT No: 214/PH/ Drought/Gen/JTO1/2015 Dt:19-02-2015

Adverting to the reference cited, it is to inform that at present live vehicle tracking system is not being implemented in most of the ULBs of the state, there by it is becoming very difficult to monitor the water supplied through water tankers and also managing the movement of vehicles employed for solid waste management. Number of grievances are being recieved daily regarding drinking water supply though water tankers and solid waste management issues .

In this regard as per the instructions of the Hon'ble Minister for Municipal Administration it is proposed to implement live vehicle tracking systems (VTS) in all the ULBs across the state. Accordingly for the purpose of fixing ceiling rates for providing VTS on rental basis in various ULBs the Superintending Engineer (PH) Guntur invited tenders (RFP) from eligible solution providers . In response to the tender call a single bid was received from M/s. Linkwell Telesystems Private Limited, Hyderabad who have quoted their rates as follows:

Servers including Solution hosting on 24/7 basis, Technical Support and Maintenance of both software and hardware on day to day basis	Up to 10	800/-
